Original Note No: A213/10. Diplomatic Missions and International Organisations are kindly requested to familiarise themselves with the updated arrangements.

Diplomatic Missions and International Organisations will be able to request batches of serial numbers from BAA that can be used with the attached **updated voucher template** to exit the NCP car park. Each voucher is **single use only** and must be surrendered after each use to the car park at the time of ticket validation. Each voucher will have a unique serial number and will permit up to 4 hours free parking.

An authorised person at each Mission is required to email the attached request form to heathrow academy@baa.com to obtain a checklist of 10 serial numbers. The authorised person will be responsible for completing the details on the voucher and issuing the unique serial number for each voucher. The vouchers should also have the Mission's official stamp. The voucher must be presented with the parking ticket & proof of identity at the car park.

Please note irrespective of the month the serial numbers have been issued these should be redeemed first before more are applied for. Additional serial numbers can be obtained by resubmitting the request form. BAA will process request within 5 working days.

Should the serial number be proven to have been issued previously, or not been issued by BAA, then the Mission will be asked to pay for their parking. Any abuse of the system could lead to further requests from the Mission in question being refused.

Protocol Directorate avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all Diplomatic Missions and International Organisations the assurances of its highest consideration.
