Her Majesty's Government presents its compliments to all Parties and Observers to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

As hosts of COP26, which will take place in Glasgow between 1-12 November this year, Her Majesty's Government has the honour to give all Parties and Observers advance notice that the World Leaders Summit segment of COP26 will take place on 1-2 November.

The World Leaders Summit is the part of COP26 where Leaders come together to agree coordinated action to tackle climate change. Our intention remains to hold the World Leaders Summit in person, respecting the wishes of all Parties. As you would expect we are considering what different COVID-19 scenarios might mean for COP26, putting the health of the participants and the local community first. In addition to planning for the event in Glasgow, we are also considering how we can build on new ways of working and advances in technology to enhance participation and inclusivity.
